Chad

Chad, officially the Republic of Chad, is a
landlocked country in Central Africa.

Capital: N'Djamena

Population: 14.45 million (2016) World Bank

President: Idriss Déby

Chad has several regions: a desert zone in the north, an arid Sahelian belt in the centre and a more fertile Sudanian Savanna zone in the south. Lake Chad, after which the country is named, is the largest wetland in Chad and the second-largest in Africa.

Chad's official languages are Arabic and French.

Chad is home to over 200 different ethnic and linguistic groups.

The major religions of Chad are Islam (at 55%), followed by Christianity (at 40%).
